Stamford Preschool

Act 166, signed into law in 2014, provides for universal access to publicly funding preschool education. This law will go into full effect in September of 2016.

Act 166 provides 10 hours of publicly funded preschool to children who are between the ages of 3 and 5 (who are not yet in kindergarten) and are 3 by September 1, 2016.

Act 166 provides young children in Vermont with opportunities to reach their full growth and developmental potential through voluntary universal access to high quality preschool education.

The necessary registration forms for Stamford students to attend Stamford Preschool in the fall will be mailed to all eligible children. These forms must be returned to us by May 12.
